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MINUTES - CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEETING

A. Town of Barnstable DPW – **stop work order** – **DA-06019** - McKeon Field

Excavation of first hole/ test pit for light installation nearest wetland without proper siltation control by

Mets. Pit beyond work limit causing disturbance of wetland. Staff working with DPW to correct situation.

Chairman Dennis Houle outlined the enforcement issues here. A recent meeting was held, with Mr. Houle in attendance, between Town agencies and private entities.

A motion was made to approve the enforcement order as written.

B. Hyannis Mets/Hyannis Athletic Assoc. c/o Jim Hurley/Atty. Mark Boudreau – McKeon Field Alteration of a wetland, river protection area and Commission's 50' buffer by placing fill and grading to expand bull pen/batting cage.

A motion was made to approve the enforcement order as written.

Seconded and voted unanimously.

C. Troy Bigelow – 29 Forest Glen Road, Hyannis – **SE3-4024 (pool)**Violation of an enforcement order dated Sept. 20, 2006, by failing to request a Certificate of Compliance.

A motion was made to approve the enforcement order as written.

D. John and Leslie Wilson Trs. – 151 Irving Ave., Hyannis – **SE3-4119**Alteration of a wetland resource area and flood zone by removing vegetation and beach grass. Work is beyond an open order of conditions for file SE3-4119, plan of record dated 12/10/03.
