A. Dr. Barry A. Lehman – 81 Farm Valley Road, Osterville SE3-3101 and DA-05090
Alteration of the Conservation Commission's 50' undisturbed buffer zone by bringing in fill and removing trees expand lawn area.

The applicant was represented by Steve Wilson, P.E.

<u>Discussion</u>: Steve Wilson stated that he will be working with Mike Ball and Bruce Bessy. Steve will prepare a plan with contour lines of the disturbed areas marked out; a copy of the plan will be given to Mr. Bessy to lay out mitigation plantings.

Permanent demarcation will be required, in consultation with staff. The Commission would prefer to see the 50-foot buffer zone restored.

A motion was made to approve the enforcement order as written.

B. Fred Donald Genova – 201 Smoke Valley Road, Osterville
Vista pruning on a coastal bank ad within 50' buffer of a marsh.
