II REQUESTS FOR DETERMINATION

Cheryl Gardner. To seek approval to replace rotten timber retaining wall with a stone face wall, same footprint; add clean sand to existing beach; replace existing stockade fence with same at 175 Holly Point Rd., Centerville as shown on Assessor's Map 232 Parcel 017. **DA-13070**
