DEMOLITION APPLICATIONS FILED. DECIDE WHETHER THE STRUCTURE IS HISTORICALLY OR ARCHITECTURALLY SIGNIFICANT, 7 WORKING DAYS FROM FILING

2 Irving Avenue, Hyannisport, Map 266, P 031

Demolition of Hezekiah Marchant House, Built late 1730's. Inventoried, not in NR or Historic District. (Located within Hyannisport Golf Course, near parking lot and maintenance buildings.)

Make an initial determination as to whether the building:

- A. It is importantly associated with one or more historic persons or events, or with the broad architectural, cultural, political, economic or social history of the town, or the Commonwealth; or
- B. It is historically or architecturally important (in terms of period, style, method of building construction, or association with famous architect or builder), either by itself or in context of a group of buildings.

Preferably-preserved significant Building – any significant as to which the Commission determines as provided in S. 112-3G of this article, that it is in the public interest to be preserved or rehabilitated rather than to be demolished.
