Mr. Nikulas explained to the Board that the house was remodeled in 2008 with a small addition and now the homeowners would like to add a detached 2 car garage located southeast to the side of the house. Colors and materials will match that of the house, white cedar singles, same windows, same pitch of the roof. Elizabeth Nilsson pointed out that it looks like the garage will be in front of the house and should they allow a structure in front of the residence. Pat Anderson noted that there really isn't any other place to put it other than if they apply

to ZBA. Mr. Nikulas added that you really will not be able to see the garage from Oak Street. Pat Anderson commented that she is pleased that there will be a minimal of clearing of trees. Mr. Nikulas stated that they will remove only one tree and pruning of some trees including a Willow tree. The existing driveway to the house is gravel and they will add to the left to access the garage.

Demolish Hunting Shack

The hunting shack is on 10 acres that was given to Mass Audubon and their position is that they want to take it down. They do not want the structure because of liability and upkeep. Pat Anderson asked if Mass Audubon wanted this land and did they know that this shack was on the property at the time of acceptance. She believes they accepted the land knowing this hunting shack was on the property. Mr. Walz indicated that discussion was had to try and move it before the land changed hands, but there were questions on who would absorb the cost. Pat Anderson gave a history of the land which was given by the Ferguson family and Mr. Walz acknowledged that he knew most of the history. Pat Anderson confirmed that the structure looks really bad, but asked if it would take a huge amount of money to bring this back. This could be one of the last remaining hunting shacks from the 1920's or 1930's. Mr. Walz commented that it would probably be the same cost to renovate it as to demolish it. Mr. Walz added that the concern of the Audubon is that they have found people sneaking onto the property and building fires in the structure. Carrie Bearse noted that would be her concern that the building could be hazardous.
