**ORDERED:** That, pursuant to the provisions of G.L. c. 44B, the sum of One Hundred Twenty Five Thousand One Hundred Forty Three and NO/100 (\$125,143.00) Dollars be appropriated and transferred from the Historic portion of the Community Preservation Fund and the sum of Ten Thousand One Hundred Seventy Two and NO/100 (\$10,172.00) Dollars be appropriated and transferred from the Undesignated portion of the Community Preservation Fund; and that the Town Manager is authorized to contract for and expend the total amount appropriated, subject to oversight of the project expenses by the Community Preservation Committee, for the preservation of the historic Hyannis Public Library to include; document preparation, site work, building construction, sill replacements, window work, painting trim and storm windows, and rebuilding the chimney of the Hyannis Public Library located at 401 Main Street, Hyannis, Map/Parcel 326/013, to be secured by a historic restriction on behalf of the Town of Barnstable.

#### **SUMMARY**

**TO:** Town Council

**FROM:** Community Preservation Committee

**DATE:** September 6, 2012

**SUBJECT:** Rationale: Hyannis Public Library – Historic Preservation

**BACKGROUND:** The Community Preservation Committee (CPC) met on Monday, March 26, 2012 and unanimously voted to recommend, to the Town Council through the Town Manager, the funding request by the Hyannis Public Library in the amount of \$135,315.00 for the Historic Preservation of the Ora A. Hinckley portion of the Hyannis Public Library located in the village of Hyannis.

**RATIONALE:** The Ora A. Hinckley building, named after the first full-time librarian, was constructed sometime between the Otis Loring House predating 1833 (in the era of whale oil lamps) facing Main Street and the Eagleston Wing of 1939. The complex is within the "Municipal Group" National Historic Register District and combined with the nearly original Post Office, the preserved Old Town Hall, the newly restored "Normal School" Town Hall and the reconstructed Asa Bearse House, makes an important contribution to the character and scale of the district.

The restoration of the building is consistent with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards and the proposed project is fully supported by the Hyannis Main Street Waterfront Historic District Commission. Preservation includes; document preparation, site work, building construction, sill replacements, window work, painting trim and storm windows and rebuilding the chimney.

Preserving truly historic buildings such as the Ora A. Hinckley building maintains a livable, historically authentic, and vibrant seaside community in Downtown Hyannis.
