

Town Council Meeting November 17, 2016



A quorum being duly present, Council President Jessica Rapp Grassetti called the November 17, 2016, Town Council meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Hearing Room of Town Hall, 367 Main St., Hyannis, MA.

An announcement was made by President Rapp Grassetti regarding the meeting being televised live and questioning if anyone was actively taping the session to please make their presence known. This session is recorded and broadcast on Channel 18.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by President Rapp Grassetti, followed by a Moment of Silence

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Dr. Joyce Young spoke about the need for a fragrance free policy. She suggested the Town of Barnstable should limit fragrance exposure in all town owned building. (Exhibit A)

John Alden who is a member of the Council on Aging discussed the delay on lighting at the Senior Center parking lot. He noted there were more classes being offered at night and with the time change the parking lot was very dark.

COUNCIL RESPONSE TO PUBLIC COMMENT:

Councilor Hebert recognized Boy Scout Troop 56 and Scoutmaster Robert Tokarz who were in the audience working on their merit badges. Councilor Hebert said he would work on getting the lights fixed at the Senior Center.

Councilor Comments and Questions:

Council would like an update regarding the Department of Public Works and the plow trucks. (Dan Santos, Director of Public Works, explained that the Global Positioning System was installed and ready to go out. He noted all fleet trucks have been outfitted and the truck crews finalized. Request for Proposals needed to address waste water treatment facility. Cape Light Compact looking for fiscal manager and a home. (Mark Milne is looking in to this situation)

Philanthropic Day celebration recognized Brendan Clark, Chairman of the Youth Commission, for all his hard work.

Update on Committee to Analyze Management of Illegal Drugs on Barnstable as a Community (sunset meeting) Discussion on ideas regarding the illegal drug problem and issues within the Town of Barnstable. Drug overdose now exceeds cancer as a top killer of people in the United States of America. Final report of committee was given to Council. (Exhibit B)

Town Manager Mark Ells gave the rationale. He discussed the Environmental Protection Agency's mandated testing for containments, carbon treatment and the final testing report. He noted the fiscal funding for the carbon treatment was funded from the cash reserves in the Enterprise Fund
