

#### Town Council Meeting April 2, 2015



quorum being duly present, Council President Jessica Rapp Grassetti called the April 02, 2015, Town Council meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Hearing Room of Town Hall, 367 Main St., Hyannis, MA.

An announcement was made by President Rapp Grassetti regarding the meeting being televised live and questioning if anyone was actively taping the session to please make their presence known. This session is recorded and broadcast on Channel 18.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by President Rapp Grassetti, followed by a Moment of Silence.

Michelle Davies, Program Coordinator, Recreation Therapeutic professional of the Year. Lynn Poyant and Debra Dagwan presented Michele Davies with a certificate of appreciation.

Owen Murray, Barnstable High School, New England Heavyweight Wrestling Champion. Coach Dr. Peter Bertucci introduced Owen Murray and discussed Owen's hard work and career highlights. President Rapp Grassetti recognized Owen Murray's accomplishments.

#### PUBLIC COMMENT:
