### BARNSTABLE LICENSING AUTHORITY SPECIAL LICENSING HEARING MINUTES Town Office Building, 200 Main Street, Hyannis, MA – 9:30 a.m. July 8, 2005

A special meeting of the Barnstable Licensing Authority was held on Friday, July 8, 2005. Chairman Martin Hoxie called the meeting to order at 2:34 P.M. He introduced Paul Sullivan, Clerk; Thomas Geiler, Director of Regulatory Services and Licensing Agent, and Christine Ade, Recording Secretary.

#### Requests:

**One Day Entertainment Licenses for Carnival:** Application of Jack Fanelli, Fanelli Amusements, Inc., 47 Barrett Road, Greenville, NH, for a **Special Permit for a Carnival** for Friday, July 8, 2005 through Sunday, July 17, 2005, to be held at the Cape Cod Mall, Iyannough Road, Hyannis from 6 pm to 10 pm each day.

Mr. Hoxie called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Martin Hoxie, Chairman, Paul Sullivan, Clerk, Tom Geiler, Licensing Agent and Sgt. Sean Sweeney, Liaison with the Barnstable Police Department and Christine Ade, Recording Secretary were present.

Jack Fanelli appeared for his application with Leo Fine, Manager of the Cape Cod Mall.

The mall carnival will run from July 8<sup>th</sup> through July 17<sup>th</sup>. He has asked for 6 pm to 10 pm every day, but after discussion, asked for 6 pm to 10 pm weekdays, noon to 11 pm Saturdays and 1 pm to 11 pm Sundays.

The carnival offers rides, games, food concessions. It has been a family business since 1956. His Dad started it. They work central Mass., Connecticut, Rhode Island, New Hampshire. Has done the carnival at the Barnstable Fair, in Orleans, Sandwich and on the Vineyard.

They have scheduled a police detail with Brian Murray. They have their health permits, building department requirements are met and got their State permits. He thought they had covered all bases until he was told Licensing needed a hearing and fees for the entertainment. He provided an employee list to the P.D. Sgt. Sweeney said there were some problems with a couple names on the list – Mr. Fanelli said by all means send an officer to take them away if need be.

Tom Geiler stated that our electrical inspector needs to come out once they are ready to go. Mr. Fanelli agreed to get this done. He already has had the State inspections.

Admission is free – this carnival is geared towards smaller children and families.

Sgt. Sweeney requested 1 hr. notice be given to the P.D. if the show is not going to open any day due to weather, etc. Mr. Fanelli agreed.

Mr. Fine thanked Mr. Hoxie and Mr. Sullivan for coming to a special meeting, stating it was not Mr. Fanelli's fault. The Mall administration will be more vigilant in future about telling these individuals what the need to do at 200 Main.

Mr. Sullivan questioned Sgt. Sweeney and Mr. Fanelli again about the "problem" employees...Sgt. Sweeney is confident that he and Mr. Fanelli can work that out.

A motion was duly made by Paul Sullivan and seconded by Martin Hoxie and a unanimous vote taken that the application of Jack Fanelli, Fanelli Amusements, Inc., 47 Barrett Road, Greenville, NH, for a **Special Permit for a Carnival** for Friday, July 8, 2005 through Sunday, July 17, 2005, to be held at the Cape Cod Mall, Iyannough Road, Hyannis from 6 pm to 10 pm weekdays, noon to 11 pm Saturdays and 1 pm to 11 pm Sundays be approved.
