

Town of Barnstable 2018 Rules & Regulations For Beaches & Parking Permits

- A. No littering or solicitation.
- B. No FIRES, glass containers, or alcohol on beach or in parking lot.
- C. Dogs are not allowed, at any time, in any beach/recreation area from May 15-September 15.
- D. Swimming is allowed in designated areas only.
- E. Flotation devices are allowed in on-shore breezes only.
- F. Lifeguards are on duty (where available) from 9AM to 5PM every day, starting in late June.
- G. Restrooms are open 9AM to 4:30PM
- H. Gates open at 9AM & are locked promptly at 9PM. Parking fees are collected from 9AM to 3:45PM (Unless otherwise posted).
- I. No beaches (including bathhouses) are staffed prior to Memorial Day weekend.
- J. Failure to comply with Beach Staff can result in loss of beach privileges, punishment by fines, and/or arrest per Town of Barnstable by-laws.
- K. No disturbances or other breach of the peace will be tolerated.
- L. All umbrellas must be secured properly and may not obstruct the lifeguard's view of the water.
- M. Any person using obscenities, particularly in a threatening manner toward TOB employees, will be asked to leave.
- N. Drones are prohibited from launching and/or landing on any Town of Barnstable beach.

RESIDENT PARKING PERMITS ARE REQUIRED YEAR ROUND (1/1/18 THRU 12/31/18) AT ALL POSTED RESIDENT BEACHES AND TOWN WAYS TO WATER

Resident Recreation Parking Permits:

Issued to vehicle registrations belonging to Year-round Barnstable Residents and/or Taxpayers and may NOT be placed on any vehicle except to the one originally issued to. **If a permit is found on a vehicle to which it was not issued, PRIVILEGE COULD BE LOST.**

Other Situations: If your Parking Permit is lost or stolen, contact us immediately so that we can nullify that permit. **Barnstable**

Recreation Division is NOT RESPONSIBLE for lost or stolen permits. If your parking permit is lost or stolen, you must purchase a new permit at FULL price.

If your permit becomes invalid, (broken windshield, new license plate, car accident, etc.), remove the original permit from the windshield and bring it (even if it comes off in pieces) to the Recreation office for a replacement permit at the cost of **\$5**; **Contingent only upon the original permit being returned.**

Guide to the 2018 Parking Permits:

***Note:** All Permits are **100% NON-TRANSFERABLE** unless otherwise noted (Landlord Transferable parking permit is the **ONLY** exception.) Except for Laminated Passes & Daily Passes (Hangs from rearview mirror,) all passes adhere to front windshield, driver's side, lower corner. **NO OTHER PLACEMENT IS VALID.**

Valid At: Craigville , Kalmus, Hathaway's Pond, Bodfish Park at Sandy Neck, Keyes, and Veteran's Valid Dates: Day of Purchase ONLY. Once Issued NO REFUNDS/NO EXCEPTIONS Issued to: Anyone with a current and valid registration. <i>For purchase at the Beach Only. Weekly Stickers available at Hyannis Youth & Community Center.</i> Barnstable Recreation is not responsible for lost or stolen permits.</p>
<p>Type: Resident Recreation Parking Permit-INDIVIDUAL Cost: \$40 Valid at: Every beach, lake, pond & ways to water in Barnstable. Valid Dates: : 1/1/18 to 12/31/18 Issued to: Individuals who are Year-round Barnstable Residents/ Taxpayers and are not licensed drivers and/or under the assistance of a caretaker. Massachusetts RMV issued Identification for Non-drivers or documentation determining year round residency in a Barnstable health care facility. Photo is required for Individual permit. <i>For purchase at the Hyannis Youth & Community Center starting May 7th, 2018</i> Barnstable Recreation is not responsible for lost or stolen permits.</p>	<p>Type: Visitor's Seasonal Parking Permit Cost: \$250 Valid at: Craigville , Kalmus, Hathaway's Pond, Bodfish Park at Sandy Neck, Keyes, and Veteran's Valid Dates: Memorial Day Weekend 2018 thru Labor Day 2018 Issued to: Anyone with a current, valid vehicle registration. <i>For purchase at the Hyannis Youth & Community starting May 7th, 2018, ONLY.</i> NOT available through Mail-In Program. Barnstable Recreation is not responsible for lost or stolen permits.</p>
<p>Type: Handicap Parking Permit Cost: \$15 (LIMIT 2) Valid at: Every beach, lake, pond & ways to water in Barnstable. Valid Dates: : 1/1/18 to 12/31/18 Issued to: Any Year-round Barnstable Resident and/or Taxpayer whose vehicle is registered to the Handicapped Individual. Proof of Taxpayer/ Residency and handicap placard w/picture ID is required along with the vehicle registration. <i>For purchase at the Hyannis Youth & Community Center (starting May 7th, 2018) and by the Mail-In Program.</i> Barnstable Recreation is not responsible for lost or stolen permits.</p>	<p>Type: Handicap Individual Parking Permit Cost: \$15 Valid at: Every beach, lake, pond & ways to water in Barnstable. Valid Dates: : 1/1/18 to 12/31/18 Issued to: Any Year-round Barnstable Resident and/or Taxpayer who does not hold a valid registration and is unable to drive, a laminated handicap individual permit with a town issued photo will be given. Proof of Taxpayer / Residency. Handicap individual MUST apply in person so their photo can be taken and present their state issued handicap placard with picture ID. <i>For purchase at the Hyannis Youth & Community Center (starting May 7th, 2018)</i> Barnstable Recreation is not responsible for lost or stolen permits.</p>
<p>Type: Visitor's Weekly Parking Permit Cost: \$70 Valid at: Craigville , Kalmus, Hathaway's Pond, Bodfish Park at Sandy Neck, Keyes, and Veteran's Valid Dates: Any consecutive 7 day period between Memorial Day 2018 thru Labor Day 2018 Issued to: Anyone with a current, valid vehicle registration. <i>For purchase at the Hyannis Youth & Community Center starting May 7th, 2018, ONLY. NOT available through Mail-In Program.</i> Barnstable Recreation is not responsible for lost or stolen permits.</p>	<p>Type: Landlord Transferable Parking Permit Cost: \$300 Valid at: Every beach, lake, pond & ways to water in Barnstable Valid Dates: : 1/1/18 to 12/31/18 Issued to: Year-round Barnstable Taxpayers and/or Property Owners. NOTE: This is the ONLY Transferable Permit. Laminated pass must be shown at the gate. Proof of taxpayer status required for purchase. <i>For purchase at the Hyannis Youth & Community Center (starting May 7th, 2018) and by the Mail-In Program. NO REFUNDS for Lost/Stolen Permits.</i> Barnstable Recreation is not responsible for lost or stolen permits.</p>

The East Bay Road Ramp/Landing sticker is still available through the Barnstable Recreation Division or the Marine and Environmental Affairs Division. Fee: \$35 for the East Bay Road Ramp/ Landing sticker ONLY or a total of \$50 when purchased with a Resident Parking Permit (\$40 for Parking Permit (Beach Sticker) plus \$10 for East Bay Road Ramp/Landing permit). Proof of Residency is required (FY18 Real Estate Tax Bill or current vehicle registration).
