TOWN OF BARNSTABLE/MARTIN J. FLYNN SCHOLARSHIP FUND

<u>Background</u>: The Barnstable Town Meeting voted on May 15, 1985 to petition the Legislature of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to allow voluntary contributions to be made to a Scholarship Fund to provide financial aid to Barnstable residents. The source of funding for the Scholarship is by a voluntary check-off on the real estate tax bill. The petition became law as Chapter 267 of the Acts of 1985. The first donations were received based upon the Fiscal 1986 tax bills.

The Scholarship Committee has met and determined that it will award several scholarships, no later than May 31st to qualified applicants. Scholarships will be given in varying amounts, not to exceed \$1000.00.

Interested applicants should seek an application from the Office of the Town Manager or online at the Town of Barnstable Web page. Complete and return the application to the Town Manager's Office no later than April 30th.

Instructions to applicant:

- 1. Complete all items on the application
- 2. Attach three letters from adults, other than relatives, who have known you for three years or more. If reapplying, attach two letters of recommendation from the present academic year preferably from an instructor/advisor/community service.
- 3. Be sure to include a high school or current college transcript.

All applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application.

Finalists, under consideration by the Scholarship Committee, may be required to attend an interview with the Scholarship Committee if it is deemed necessary.
