• Approval of the Draft Community Preservation Committee Regular Meeting Minutes from June 2, 2025.

Applications:

- Application from Town of Barnstable DPW requesting \$406,282 in Community Preservation Open Space and Recreation funds to revitalize and improve Cotuit Memorial Park located at 889 Main Street, Cotuit, map 035, parcel 051. The total estimated project cost is \$520,434 with \$114,152 in capital improvement funding to be provided. The Cotuit Civic Association has requested the rejuvenation of this park that is a focal point for the village connecting the library, waterfront, playground, and post office. *Continued from the June 2, 2025 CPC meeting.*
- Application from Barnstable Land Trust (BLT) requesting \$307,500 in Community Preservation Open Space funds to preserve an ecologically important retired cranberry bog property consisting of 25.74 acres within the Great Marsh and Barnstable Harbor watershed addressed 301 Parker Road, West Barnstable, map 176, parcel 019. The total purchase price is \$615,000 and BLT will apply for an MA Conservation Partnership Grant in June 2025 to help fund the acquisition. BLT will grant a conservation restriction to the Town of Barnstable to ensure the land is preserved in perpetuity.

- The West Barnstable Railroad Depot Restoration DPW request was appropriated at June 5, 2025, Town Council public hearing.
- Cotuit Highground Conservation Restriction request was appropriated at the June 5, 2025, Town Council public hearing.
- The Town Council continued the DPW's Hyannis Armory Restoration CPC Application to their September 4, 2025, meeting.
- Conservation Restrictions for the Harju and Prince Avenue properties are being reviewed and will be placed on an upcoming Town Council agenda for approval.
- The consultant has completed work on the required Form E associated with the Letter of Intent from South Congregational Church Burial Ground. MHC had determined an updated Form E is required to facilitate the completion of the draft preservation restriction from 2017.
- The consultant completed the building condition assessment for the Oddfellow Lodge and consultant's work on the preservation restriction has begun.

- A Letter of Intent seeking funds for trail signage to be located on town-owned conservation property is anticipated for the September 2025 CPC meeting from the Planning & Development Department.
- Barnstable Land Trust will be submitting their Application on the Monteiro project at a future date.
