The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chair F. P. (Tom) Lee. Also attending were Vice-Chair Louise R. Foster, Clerk Dennis R. Houle, Commissioners John E. Abodeely, Peter Sampou, and George Gillmore. Larry Morin was not in attendance.

Conservation Administrator Darcy Karle and Kim Cavanaugh assisted.

I NOTICES OF INTENT

Arthur & Terrie R. Zeikel, Trs./The Terrie Zeikel Trust. Remove and replace existing boardwalk, pier, ramp and float with new boardwalk, pier, ramp and float, extending approx. 6' further into river with 8' x 25' float L to west side at 129 Main St., Osterville as shown on Assessor's Map 165 Parcel 078. **SE3-5609**

Correspondence: A request for continuance was made via email received on September 18, 2018 from Chuck Rowland of Sullivan Engineering.

No testimony was taken.

A motion was made to continue the project to October 2, 2018.

Seconded and voted unanimously.

Stephen W. Kidder, Tr. & Mark B. Elefante, Tr./225 Ocean Avenue Realty Trust u/d/t. Relocation of one tie-off pile and installation of boatlift on southwest side of end platform of existing pier at 225 Ocean View Ave., Cotuit as shown on Assessor's Map 033 Parcel 041. SE3-5610

Arlene Wilson represented the applicant.

Discussion:

- The pier on the easterly side for the kayak lift has a Certificate of Compliance.
- The lift is necessary for handicap accessibility. Medical need qualifies under Chapter 703-4 Q (2) (a).

• Discussion of other types of lifts such as a swivel chair from piling or other types of lifts.

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- Piling being relocated is moving toward pier. No piling moving further southwest addresses the Harbor Masters
- Commission reviewed how the proposal meets the requirements listed in Q (3) a-d.
- Further discussion on (d). There is currently bottom paint on the boat.

A motion was made to approve a finding that the application qualifies under 703-4 Q (2) (a): there is a demonstrated medical need.

Seconded and voted unanimously.

Motion to approve the project as submitted with two special conditions:

- 1. When there is no longer a demonstrated medical need, or when the property is transferred or sold, the boat lift, elevator or davits must be removed and the Conservation Division notified.
- 2. When it is time to repaint the bottom of the vessel, the bottom of the vessel will not be repainted, or will be repainted with non-toxic bottom paint.

Seconded and voted unanimously.
