I NOTICES OF INTENT

Joseph Graziosi. Construct a low earthen vegetated berm on lawn area between existing residence and salt marsh as a means of preventing tidal floodwaters from reaching house foundation and crawl space area at 1085 Craigville Beach Rd., Centerville as shown on Assessor's Map 206 Parcel 100. **SE3-5614 \$50.00**

The applicant was represented by Mike Ball of Baxter Nye Engineering.

Issues Discussed:

- Recommendations of the Commonwealth of Mass. manual regarding wetlands regulations and considerations for Conservation Commissions to protect the storm damage prevention and flood control function of coastal resource areas.
- Discussion of comments received by DEP read into record. The Commissioners needs time to review.
- DEP is working on performance standards.

There is a broad consensus that small projects don't solve the problem. Regulations will not come into play until late 2019. Larger projects will have different standards.

The applicant was represented by Seth Wilkinson of Wilkinson Ecological Design.

Issues Discussed:

- Review of revised plan dated 10/11/18.
- Vista management plan, utilizing coppicing and restorative pruning techniques.
- Projection of tree canopy size for species to be managed within the project area.
- Removal of some of the trees would be beneficial. Increasing small hollies for diversity. Better habitat and more pleasing.

Motion to approve the project based on the revision submitted of October 9 and October 11, 2018 with special conditions:

- 1. Commission will allow for revision of this project, in that as you go through the process you may see hollies if it would be determined to be successful.
- 2. Project shall be overseen by a Certified Ecological Restoration Practitioner.
- 3. Commission to receive annual reports for three years.
- 4. Submit COC re-docketing request letter with fee to close out SE3-4761.
