Staff Report:

Nina Coleman addressed the Board:

- Memorial Weekend was good and the next weekend even better. Extremely busy.
- Gatehouse is open daily from 8 am to 9 pm. (The Gatehouse is staffed 24 hours but not open to the public).
- The beach curfew is 11:00 pm. You must be airing up and off the beach by 11:00 pm. You must be past the Gatehouse by 9:00 pm to stay on the beach until 11:00 pm.
- The concession stand is open with limited hours. They will be open 7 days a week starting on June 21st until Labor Day. Sunday Thursday 10:00 am 7:00 pm. Friday and Saturday: 10:00 am 9:00 pm. Visit their Facebook page, Snack Shack at Sandy Neck Beach. Good food!
- Beach closure happened today (June 9th). Closed east of Trail 2 which means open for 2 miles. Now 26 plover nests. 11 still in eggs. 8 have hatched. 6 were predated and one was abandoned. Terns are nesting now. Trail 6 to the point is where most of the nests are located. Excellent habitat in that area.
- Diamond Terrapins nest activity is occurring. There was a "Headstarted" Turtle release on Sunday. Over hundred people were present. More releases soon.
- There will be a turtle walk "In Search of Diamondback Terrapins on Sandy Neck" on Wednesday July 9th from 10 am noon. Sandy Neck Manager Nina Coleman and Mass Audubon's Ian Ives will lead this walk. - July 4th should be a busy weekend with two miles of beach open. Parking plan with 30 foot corridor will be in place.
