I. CALL TO ORDER:

Frederick Komenda called the meeting to order at 7pm.

II. MINUTES:

IV. MOORING APPEALS:

Mooring permit will be approved pending completion of a mooring permit application, inspection of mooring, and receipt of all required fees: FY09- \$70, FY10- \$70 and mooring reinstatement fee \$25.

V. OLD BUSINESS:

Barnstable Harbor Bulkhead update. Eric Shufelt reported that the Town of Barnstable held a bid opening for the Barnstable Harbor bulkhead repair. There were 18 bids submitted to the Town and are being reviewed. Once the contractor has been selected and the contract signed, we will find out what limitations there will be during construction. The low bid was from CRC, Co., Inc. from Quincy for \$2,334,249.

Coastal Access Plan update. Joe Gibbs reported that in the spring docks will be added along the bulkhead at the Gary Brown boat ramp as dredging is now complete there. West Bay bulkhead completed but drainage work still needs to be done. We are waiting to hear about the consultants report to repair the Millway boat ramp. We recently asked for consideration for the Centerville River/Haywood Ave ramp as well as the Prince Cove ramp. They are using new signage to promote the Towns Ways to Water, looking at repairing or redesigning the Bay Street parking lot.

We believe the State is going to replace the floats at Blish Point.

The Town Clerk's memo giving an overview of Executive Session was handed out to the committee members.

VIII. HARBORMASTER REPORT:

Mooring and Marina wait list renewals went out January 1st and we must receive them in our office by March 15th at 4:15pm. There is no appeal process.

Mooring renewals will be going out February 5th. They are due in the office by March 31st with a late renewal period ending May 14th for an additional \$25.
