 - ii. School open house dates will be determined
- e. One Love

 - 2. More people are needed to run the program
 - i. Shalanda is a part of Hope Squad and can work to get their participation
 - ii. Possibly go to the classrooms to have discussions during Stable time for a better effect
 - iii. Honors Students have more to gain for participation than the Hope Squad members do
 - iv. Individual classrooms were used in the past and it went well with Lucas on Zoom doing the introduction and discussions happening after that

 - 1. Barnstable Public School Superintendent wants to do an event with the Youth Commission
 - i. George will follow up on this
