From the rotunda, one looks out across Lewis Bay to Yarmouth. It was here on Lewis Bay, in Hyannis Harbor and on Nantucket Sound that President Kennedy swam and sailed. His presidential yacht, the Patrick J., was a familiar sight on summer weekends.

The inscription on the pool rim inside the railing is from one of President Kennedy's speeches..."I believe it is important that this country sail and not lie still in the harbor."
