Veterans Day Activities in the Town of Barnstable

Veterans Day Parade to be held on Monday, November 11th

HYANNIS, MA - This year's Veterans Day Parade will take place on Monday, November 11th at 10:00 AM. The parade will form next to the Town Hall Building, extending back to the Village Green. The parade will step off promptly at 10:00 AM. The parade will conclude at the Hyannis Village Green for the Annual Barnstable Soldiers Veterans' Day Program. This year's keynote speaker is Colonel (Retired) Scott A. Romberger who joined the EOM Offshore team in November of 2017 as the Chief Operating Officer. Scott and his family have recently relocated to Cape Cod following a successful 23-year career in the United State Air Force, where Scott retired as a Colonel. Scott brings executive leadership and proven program management from the government and international arenas. He's an expert in analyzing existing operations and implementing winning strategies to improve organizational performance, growth, and sustainability. Scott began his Air Force career as a program manager launching national security satellites from Cape Canaveral, Florida. Since then, he's held several positions in various locations around the world in intelligence, international affairs, and joint operations, to include serving as a national security policy advisor and a U.S. negotiator to several foreign countries. Scott has commanded multiple Air Force organizations at increasing levels of seniority and has provided subject matter expertise to the Joint Chiefs of Staff and to the President's National Security Council. Scott holds a Bachelor's, four Master's degrees, and is a graduate of the U.S. Naval War College, specializing in advanced studies in missile defense and undersea warfare. Scott resides in Falmouth with his wife Heather and their four children. After several moves with the Air Force, Scott and his family look forward to settling down and enjoying everything the Cape has to offer.
