

Water Testing of Private Wells

Barnstable County is seeking Cape-wide volunteers for free private well water screening





Barnstable County and Tetra Tech are looking for volunteers to collect and submit samples of their private well water for water quality testing at no cost to you, a value of over \$400. In conjunction with the Barnstable County Department of Health and Environment, the collected samples will be tested for a variety of pollutants, including emerging contaminants like PFAS.






