



Each year, the Cape Cod Metropolitan Planning Organization, with advisement from the Joint Transportation Committee, guidance from Cape Cod Commission transportation staff, and input from the public, helps to create the Transportation Improvement Program and Unified Planning Work Program to guide funding for Infrastructure Improvement projects on Cape Cod.

Graduate students from the MIT Renewable Energy Facility Siting Clinic are hoping to hear from as many Barnstable community members as possible regarding their views about offshore wind power.

Clinic staff will summarize what they hear, without mentioning anyone by name, to contribute to a genuine community conversation. The goal is to understand the full spectrum of perspectives in Barnstable—and based on those diverse views in the community, to suggest to the Town what a more inclusive planning process could look like.

The Clinic is piloting "drop in" Zoom sessions for individual community members to share their ideas related to offshore wind directly with the Clinic staff.






