Wear long-sleeved shirts and long pants.

For extra protection, treat clothing with permethrin.



Mosquito-proof your home.

Use screens on windows and doors. Use air conditioning if available. Keep mosquitoes from laying eggs in or near standing water.






On the surface, a drum circle is pretty much what it sounds like—people gathering together to tap, hit, shake or strike some type of drum to create a rhythmic beat.
