

PERTUSSIS (WHOOPING COUGH) CASES RISING IN BARNSTABLE COUNTY

Pertussis, also called "whooping cough", is a common and highly contagious bacterial respiratory infection that can be dangerous, especially to young infants. In older children, teens, and adults, the symptoms of pertussis are often mild, but can last for weeks or months.

Early symptoms can resemble a mild cold, starting with a persistent runny nose and sneezing, low grade fever, sore throat, and a mild occasional cough that can worsen into coughing fits after 1 to 2 weeks. These coughing fits come on suddenly and can be severe.

Protecting yourself and your community by recognizing pertussis symptoms, seeking medical advice promptly, and following treatment recommendations. For additional resources and updates, click **HERE**.

2025 PARKING FEE INCREASES



KEY CHANGES INCLUDE:

Fines for illegal parking in handicap spaces and ADA access aisles and Fire Lanes will increase from \$100.00 to \$200.00. This adjustment reflects the Town's dedication to ensuring that essential access for the disabled and emergency routes remains clear and available for those who need them most.

Fines for all other parking violations, including meter violations, overtime parking, parking without a permit or beach parking regulation violations will increase from \$40.00 to \$50.00. This change aims to encourage adherence to parking regulations across the community.


Barnstable Police Department took top spot in the 29th annual United States Marine Corps toys-for-tots stuff-a-bus event!

Each treasured friend will be given a special name tag and kept under careful watch until reunited with their owners.








