Municipal Marina Guidance

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 Global Health Pandemic, the Town of Barnstable Marine and Environmental Affairs Department has implemented the following social distancing guidelines for Town of Barnstable municipal marinas until further notice.

Please adhere to the following guidelines when visiting the Town of Barnstable municipal marinas

Protecting yourself while at Town of Barnstable municipal marinas:

- Marina dockage access is only permitted to slip holders or transient slip holders.
- All users while accessing the docks or property should abide by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) social distancing measures.
- Per Governor Baker, face masks are required (over the age of 5) whenever in public, indoors or outdoors. Please, refer to the Mass.gov website for updated information pertaining to "Boating & Various other Marine and Inland Waterway Related Activities". The link to obtain updated information is available on the Town of Barnstable, Harbormaster website.
- Staffing will available but certain requests may be by appointment only. Staff will take all necessary precautions to abide by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) social distancing measures.
- Charter or Vessels for Hire should follow Massachusetts Guidance pertaining to "Hire for Charter" available on Mass.gov.
- Bathrooms will open to the public May 1.
- Failure to abide by guidelines may result in the closure of municipal marinas.
- All Town of Barnstable rules, regulations and laws still apply.
