

## LOCAL REGULATIONS

The Town of Barnstable adopted Regulations which are stricter than 105 CMR 590.000, State Sanitary Code, Article X and the 1999 Federal Food Code. The local Ordinances may be reviewed at the following link:

The following summarizes some or most of these Regulations:

- Push-cart type food-vendors are not permitted in Barnstable;
- An in-ground grease trap is required at a food establishment wherever foods are prepared and/or cooked.
- Toilet facilities, which are accessible without traveling through a food preparation area, are required for patrons.
- Dumpster areas must be screened from public view (i.e. fenced-in);
- Handwash sink faucets and bathrooms sink faucets must be hands- free (i.e. wrist paddles, electronic, foot pedals, or knee pedals);
- Screens and electronic air curtains are required at doorways used by wait-staff wherever outside dining is provided. Variances may be granted by the Board of Health in this regard if the [applicant proposes some other](#) combination of [two](#) protective barriers ([i.e closing off the kitchen area and electronic air curtains along the open doorways](#)). Please see [the](#) attached link for the complete list of outside dining requirements;
- A separate service sink is required for washing fruits and vegetables. This sink is separate from the required triple compartment or double compartment warewashing sink.
