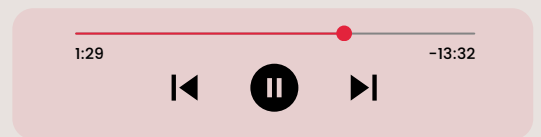

## Mosquitoes spread germs



### Mosquitoes bite day and night.

Mosquitoes that spread viruses  
bite during the day and night and  
live indoors and outdoors.



### Use insect repellent. It works!

Look for the following active  
ingredients: DEET, picaridin,  
IR3535, oil of lemon eucalyptus,  
para-menthane-diol, or  
2-undecanone.



### Wear long-sleeved shirts and long pants.

For extra protection, treat  
clothing with permethrin.



### Mosquito-proof your home.

Use screens on windows and  
doors. Use air conditioning  
if available. Keep mosquitoes  
from laying eggs in or near  
standing water.

# Long-Term Strategic Planning Sessions

The Cape Cod Gateway Airport is about to embark on the development of a long-term strategic plan. To do so, the Airport believes that the involvement of a broad representation of the airport community and the area it serves will provide the most comprehensive outcome.

Participation involves attending a series of meetings over the course of four weeks.

Each meeting will be held from 5 to 7 PM and will be broken down into the following sessions:

- Session 1: Training on the MVP Strategic Planning Model (Aug 19th)
- Session 2: Development of statements of Mission, Vision, and Philosophy (Aug 26th)
- Session 3: Development of Goals and Objectives (Sep 9th)
- Session 4: Final review of the Airport MVP Strategic Plan (Sep 23rd)

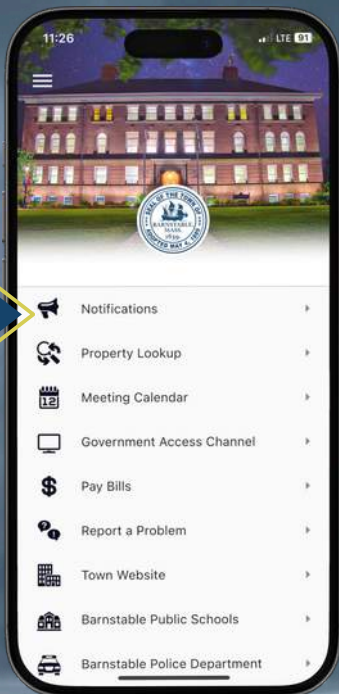

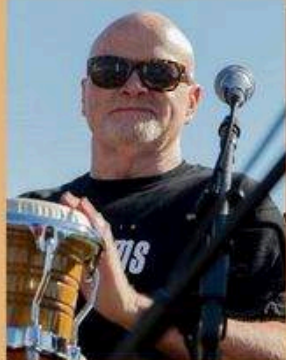

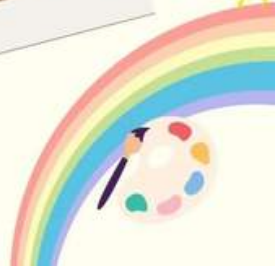
