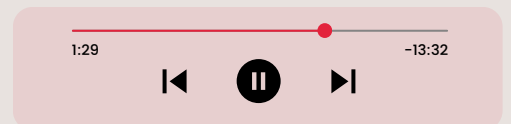

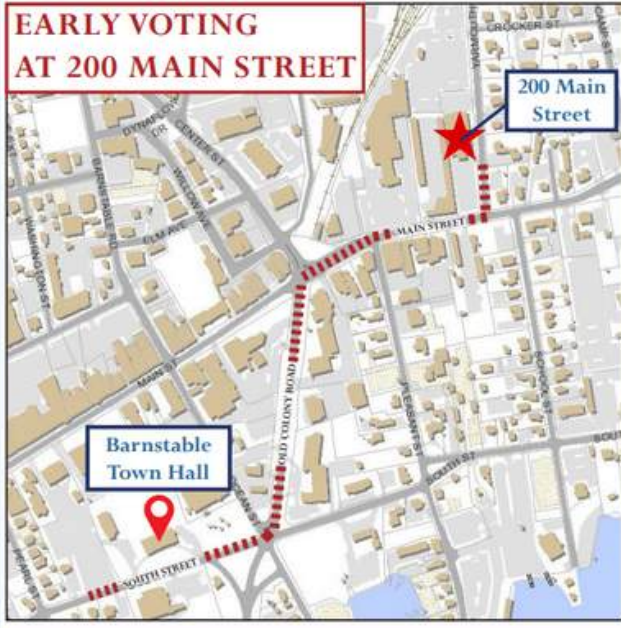

August 31: Overdose Awareness Day



Problem: Individuals die before they get treatment.

- Thousands of lives have been lost to opioid-related deaths between 2001 and 2023 in Massachusetts.
- 2022: peak year with 2,357 deaths
- 2023: 10% reduction in fatalities, but the crisis continues.

The Solution: Evidence-Based Harm Reduction Methods

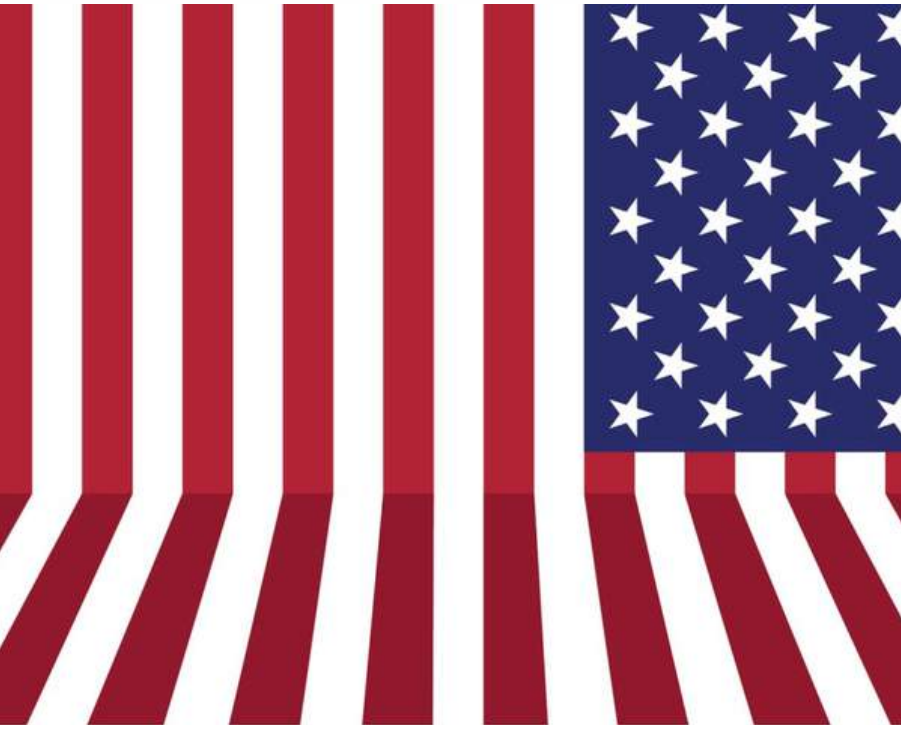
There are many harm reduction methods, one of the most effective ways to prevent death and disease are needle exchange programs.

- **CDC Findings:** Participants in these programs are 5x more likely to enter treatment.
- Participants are nearly 3x more likely to reduce or stop injecting drugs.

Local Resource

The AIDS Support Group of Cape Cod operates needle exchanges in Provincetown, Hyannis, and via a mobile van on the Upper Cape.
