

PUBLIC COMMENT MAY ALSO BE SUBMITTED IN WRITING The Community Preservation Act (CPA) is a state law passed in 2000 that allows Massachusetts communities to conduct a referendum to add a small surcharge on local property taxes.

When combined with matching funds from the statewide Community Preservation Trust Fund, this dedicated fund is used to build and rehabilitate parks, playgrounds, and recreational fields, protect open space, support local affordable housing development, and preserve historic buildings and resources.

The Community Preservation Committee is seeking public input on how this CPA funding source should be utilized for Fiscal Year 2025.




