



The Remember Balloons written by Jessie Oliveros and illustrated by Dana Wulfekotte is a Schneider Family Book award winner. This touching and poignant story gives a sense of value to those with memory impairment and provides a connection for the family members affected. A family member's dementia influences the entire family, including children. Parents might want to shield young children from the reality of their loved one's condition, but it is best to broach the topic with them soon after the diagnosis. Children are often able to sense tensions in family dynamics arising from your loved one's diagnosis of dementia and may be able to adjust to these changes if they are informed.
