

THE BARNSTABLE TRANSFER STATION HAS IMPLEMENTED A LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION SYSTEM THAT HAS REPLACED THE TRADITIONAL "STICKER" SYSTEM. USERS WILL NO LONGER BE ISSUED PHYSICAL STICKERS FOR THEIR VEHICLES. ONCE ACCEPTED, YOUR PERMIT WILL BECOME VALID WITHIN FIVE MINUTES AND YOU BE ABLE TO ACCESS THE SOLID WASTE DIVISION'S TRANSFER STATION & RECYCLING CENTER.

If at any time you need to use a different vehicle or if your license plate changes, please stop at the office and you will be accommodated to the best of our ability.


