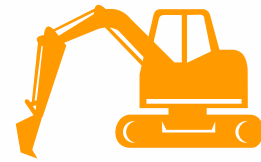

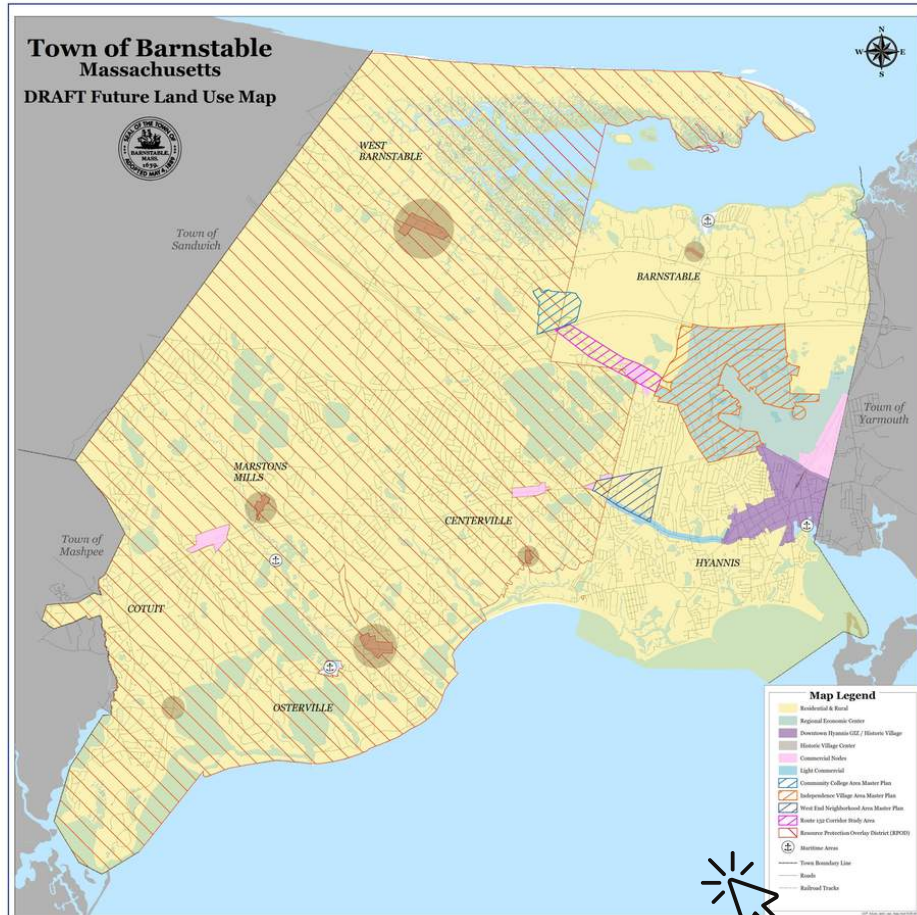
The **Local Comprehensive Planning Committee** is conducting an exercise to update the Town's Future Land Use Map with proposed land use study areas that will guide Barnstable's future over the next 10 years. The LCP Committee is seeking feedback regarding the proposed land use study areas:

- ▶ Should any of the study areas be amended?
- ▶ Are there additional study areas that should be identified?

The Draft Future Land Use Map is accessible for review and comment from the Town's Local Comprehensive Plan website BarnstableLCP.com via the "Future Land Use Map" tab. The public comment period for the Draft Future Land Use Map is open through close of business Wednesday October 23rd.

Future Land Use Map Study Areas

- Residential & Rural
 - Existing residential zoning districts
- Regional Economic Center
 - Existing commercial district
- Downtown Hyannis GIZ/Historic Village
 - Existing Hyannis Growth Incentive Zone
- Historic Village Center
 - Identified to be preserved as quintessential New England Main Street
- Commercial Nodes
 - Existing mixed-use/commercial districts
- Light Commercial
 - Identified as a corridor to study for traffic impacts and to analyze proper land uses
- Community College Area Master Plan
 - Identified as a location for further future land use study in partnership with the Community College
- Independence Village Area Master Plan
 - Identified as a location for further future land use study
- West End Neighborhood Area Master Plan
 - Identified to study corridor traffic and to analyze proper land uses
- Route 132 Corridor Study Area
 - Identified to study corridor traffic and to analyze proper land uses
- Resource Protection Overlay District (RPOD)
 - Existing 2-acre zoning superimposed over existing residential zoning districts to protect groundwater quality

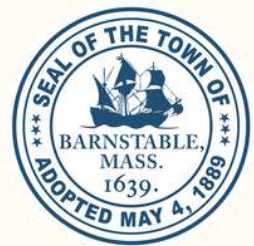

FLU AND COVID-19 VACCINE CLINIC FOR CHILDREN AND ADULTS AGES 12+

The Barnstable County Public Health Nursing Division will hold a flu and COVID-19 vaccination clinic for children and adults ages 12 and older. Registration is required; walk-ins will not be accepted. Please have your insurance information available prior to registration.

The updated 2024/2025 Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine will be offered as a primary or booster vaccine, in addition to the updated 2024/2025 trivalent flu vaccine, available in regular dose and high-dose (for adults 65+).

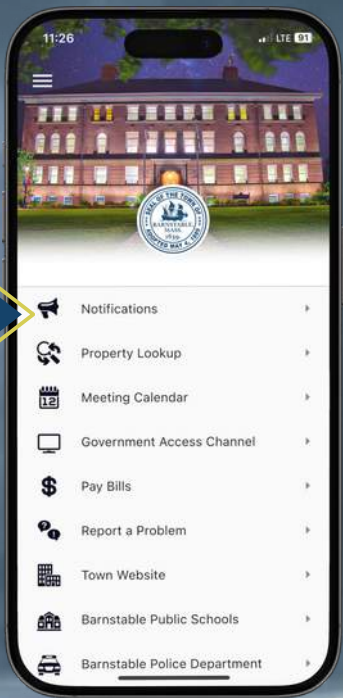

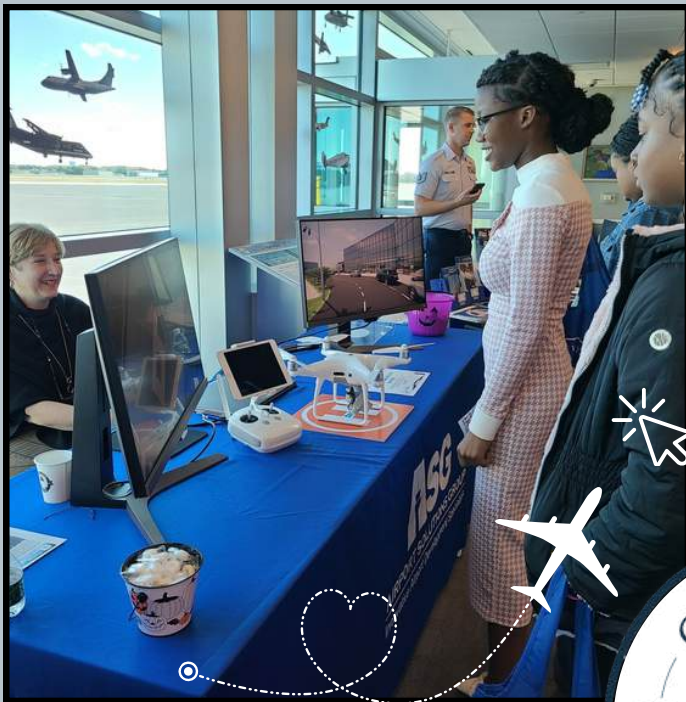
