

2019 Looking Forward

- Busier shoulder seasons + off-season
 - Increased use year-round
 - Negative wildlife interactions (people and pets)
 - Hunter/hiker interactions
 - Lightly staffed
- Gatehouse/Sandy Neck Road Safety
 - Permanent speed bumps and stop signs
 - Speed radar sign on Sandy Neck Road
 - Pedestrian crossing signs and information
 - Increased Enforcement
- RFID System

2019 Looking Forward

- Access Trail Safety
 - Additional air-up location
 - Increased staff in area during busy days
- Parking Lot Safety
 - Deteriorating conditions in lower lot
 - Emergency access issues
 - ORV Patrons in parking lot
- Shark Incident Updates/Response
 - Use of Sandy Neck App
 - New signage, flags, response protocols
 - Stop the bleed kits and training
- Family/Quiet Zone

2020 and beyond

- Possible use of reservation system
- Possible use of a lottery system
- Possible limit on permit availability
- Reduce curfew for daytrippers
- Limiting camper sizes allowed on the beach
- Long-Term Coastal Resiliency Project
